The Tennis Foundation of Mississippi is pleased to announce that William G. Clark (Billy Gip) of Columbus & Rodney (Rod) Mills Hartzog (posthumously) are the 2021 inductees into the Tennis Foundation of Mississippi Hall of Fame. The inductees into the Tennis Hall of Fame have long been associated with tennis in the state and through their play, support, and generosity have left an unmistakable imprint on Mississippi tennis.

Rod Hartzog spent a lifetime in tennis. Rod graduated from Meridian High School in 1969 being awarded a tennis scholarship to attend Ole Miss where he started as a freshman. He was a lifetime member of USTA as well as a PTR certified teaching professional his entire teaching career. Rod was the SEC youngest men's tennis team coach at Mississippi State University at the age of 24 in 1975-76. He pursued further experience in his tennis teaching career reaching out to international opportunities.

Those opportunities gave him experience teaching with the legendary Harry Hopman in Florida and Italy. He spent time in Asia and West Germany before returning to Meridian where he served as the Director of Tennis at Northwood Country Club from 1983-2003. He spent many years at facilities throughout the Delta area of Mississippi serving as the Director of Tennis for the Greenwood Country Club, Indianola Country Club, and Lake Village. Willis Frazer, a longtime friend, said "Rod was a beloved friend by all those fortunate enough to know him". He was full of life with a distinctive, infectious laugh. Previous to his passing, he was hired by the University for Women in Columbus Mississippi as they were preparing to bring not only the Women's Tennis program back but add a Men's program He passed away in August of 2018.

William (Billy Gip) Clark is one of those tennis enthusiasts that drives his enthusiasm as a player, parent, and coach. Easily added to his impressive resume is officiating and volunteerism. There are countless stories of a quality tennis parent from those that competed against the Clark family but also as he moved his career to coaching.

He was the Heritage Academy high school tennis coach for 15 years and produced 5 state championships during that time. HIs teaching and tennis program directing career took him from Greenwood to Cleveland Country Club and he is now serving as the Director of Tennis at Magnolia Tennis Club in Columbus. He has produced 7 state adult league championship teams while introducing tennis to youth and adults alike. He has been an avid USTA official currently serving as the chairman for the USTA Mississippi Officials Committee. He will travel from city to city when tournament directors call him in for his referee

experience. Fellow officials have appreciated his mentoring as he has been instrumental in recruiting new officials. He has also shared his experience serving as a Mississippi Tennis Association Board member. Known for being an exemplary family man, he continues to advocate for all to become the tennis enthusiast he has demonstrated to be.

Now in its twenty-first year, the program awards scholarships each year to a deserving young man and woman based on their accomplishments in the classroom, on the tennis court, and in the community.



Lydia is a graduating senior in Jackson from the Magnolia Homeschool program. She has achieved a GPA of 4.0 throughout her high school educational career, where she is also a member of the ACT 30+ club. She has also pursued coaching accomplishments being a Professional Tennis Registry certified coach. She served the community with numerous volunteer opportunities such as local Arthur Ashe Tennis Camp coach, physical therapy volunteer, as well as human trafficking awareness. Having been an avid USTA tournament participant, playing her first tournament before the age of 10 and becoming one of the state's top players earning a spot on the Southern Cup team as well as participating in every age division of Southern's Closed sectional tournaments. These tennis accomplishments came after sustaining a serious injury while a 12's participant. This injury was nearly a full year of recovery, slowly getting back the strength to continue pursuing her fullest potential as a competitor. Jacob is from Shannon and has achieved a 4.36 GPA throughout his high school career. He is a STAR Student, Valedictorian, Scholar Athlete, Woodman of Life Scholarship Award, and a US Presidential Scholar candidate. He has pursued extracurricular activities such as Beta Club, Mu Alpha Theta, Library Club, both the tennis and soccer teams, Scholars Bowl and 4-H. Other community accomplishments range from being the state 4-H ambassador, US Congressional Gold Medal, Diabetes Researcher with TrialNet through Vanderbilt University, as well as the co-founder of the Blessing Bag ministry which delivers supplemental food to those in need. Being introduced to tennis at a very early age through a family with a long history of tennis participation, he played on a Quick Start 8 and under team out of the Tupelo area. How does it work?

USTA Junior Team Tennis is one of the fastest growing team sports in the country, and allows kids ages 5-18 to form teams with anywhere from 8 to 16 of their friends at the Beginner, Intermediate, or Advanced levels. Those that advance out of local play have an opportunity to progress to State, Sectional, and National Championship events. Leagues have the option to use multiple different formats that are a fit with their community, and scoring can be done in a unique way as well. Teams that win the most total games in the entire team match are named the match winner, so remember, in Junior Team Tennis, EVERY GAME COUNTS.

USTA Jr Team Tennis Highlights

USTA Jr Team Tennis will now offer three Championship opportunities. The National Championship Track (NCJTT) will kick off by having an "open" championship on May 14-15. The NCJTT tournament will be open to ANYONE that wants to field a team, and winners will be eligible to advance to the Sectional & National Championships. The traditional Summer Jr Team Tennis season will kickoff in June, and qualifying teams will advance to the Mississippi JTT State Championship July 29-31. That league will be coed and the format will be boys and girls singles, and boys and girls doubles.

In the Fall JTT League, boys and girls teams are separate, and team matches consist of 4 singles matches and 2 doubles matches. The Fall JTT League will conclude with a Fall State Championship November 19-20.
